The Teen and College Art Search: FestivALL's Quest for Emerging Artists is an annual event produced by Charleston Town Center, which searches for the most visually artistic teens & college students, & showcases a selection of art work at the Mall during FestivALL in June.



- Art Exhibit Dates:
 - Opens Thursday, June 14 at 3:00 p.m. through Monday, June 18
- Who is invited to participate?
 - Artists in middle school, high school & college students, ages 13-23, who reside and attend school in Boone, Braxton, Cabell, Clay, Fayette, Greenbrier, Jackson, Kanawha, Lincoln, Nicholas, Putnam, Raleigh & Roane Counties.
- Where does this take place?
 - o Center Court, Charleston Town Center, Lee and Quarrier Streets, Downtown Charleston
- Additional Guidelines & Information:
 - All mediums are accepted.
 - All entry forms and submissions of artwork must be received no later than June 1, and as early as January 8,
 2018. Entry forms must be completed for each piece of artwork submitted.
 - o Teachers may submit student work and teen & college students may submit individual artwork independently.
 - Students or teachers are responsible for delivering artwork and entry forms, which must accompany every piece of art entered, to Charleston Town Center & Mall Management Office and they must be submitted between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
 - Bring all entries to the "Attention Lisa McCracken," to the Mall Management Office, located on Level Three in the Picnic Place Food Court.
 - o Work must be marked with "NFS" if it is not for sale or with a \$ price if otherwise.
 - Works on walls should be matted for display. This year no artwork of any kind will be accepted if it is framed. All works-on-walls are to be matted only.
 - o Artwork may be no taller than 3', no wider than 3', and may not weigh more than six pounds.
 - Student's name and contact information must appear on the back of the work, or alongside sculptures.
 - Students and teachers are responsible for picking up artwork on Monday, June 18 between noon and 5:00 p.m. in Center Court.
 - All submitted work will be judged by a panel of professional WV artists, representing the mediums of painting, drawing, photography, graphic art, sculpture, stained glass & textiles. Judging takes place on Thursday, June 14.
 - Prizes to be awarded include a \$500 cash Purchase Award, one \$300 'Best in Show' Mall Gift Card Award, three \$100 school category Mall Gift Card Awards, and one \$50 'Crowd Favorite' Mall Gift Card Award. Public voting for 'Crowd Favorite' Award will take place during the exhibit. Plus 'Best in Show' winner receives a private 30-minute art chat with the judge representing their medium.
 - Any artwork not picked up on Monday, June 18by 5:00 p.m. will become property of Charleston Town Center.
 - o Charleston Town Center is not responsible for any costs, damage, breakage, vandalism or theft of artwork.
 - Students and teachers shall and will indemnify and hold harmless the owner and all merchants' leasing or owning space in Charleston Town Center Mall, their demands, expenses, fee, fines, penalties, suits, proceedings, actions, and causes of action of any and every kind and nature arising or growing out of or in any way connected with the use or occupancy of Charleston Town Center Mall.
